#### 1. INVITATION

Barrie Yacht Club invites sailors in Kirby 25, Olson 25 and Olson 30 to come and race in the One Design Regatta in Barrie. Classes must have 5 or more entrants.

- OLSON 30 Racing 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>. Long Distance Race (not discardable) and 3 days of course racing for their North American Championship.
- KIRBY 25 Racing 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> 2 days of course racing for the Doug Kirk Invitational.
- OLSON 25 Racing 10<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> 2 days of course racing for Olson 25 Canadian Nationals.

#### 2. SITE

The Regatta will be hosted by the Barrie Yacht Club, racing to be on Lake Simcoe and Kempenfelt Bay.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY

The Regatta is open to designated classes; boats duly registered meeting equipment and measurement requirements of the appropriate class association. Where required competitors must be fully paid up members of their Class Association. Participants must have paid all event fees before beginning the official competition.

#### 4. RULES

The Regatta will be covered by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the Olson 30, Kirby 25 & Olson 25 Class Rules. In the event of a conflict in translation, the English version will prevail.

## 5. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

# 9. PENALTY SYSTEMS

The penalties as per the RRS. For some classes Rule 44.1 may be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required for an infringement of a rule of part 2.

## 10. SCORING

Low point system as per appendix A.

The number of races required to constitute a series is one.

The number of drop races shall be outlined in the race instructions.

Maximum number of races – Olson 30 – 11 + LD (4 Fri/5 Sat/2 Sun)

#### 11. FEES

Olson 30 - \$140.00/Boat
Kirby 25 - \$65.00/Boat
Olson 25 - \$65.00/Boat
Thursday Night Supper - \$10.00 per person
Saturday Night Dinner - \$18.00 per person

Entry Fee includes Continental Breakfasts and Post Racing BBQ on Sunday.

#### 12. PRIZES & AWARDS

Awards include perpetual trophies and 'keepers'.

#### 13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. They BYC will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

#### 14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance, and have proof of such insurance on site.

#### 15 FURTHER INFORMATION

#### **BAR**

The licenced area of the BYC is the Great Room and the Balcony. Alcohol purchased at the bar cannot be taken downstairs. Personal alcohol can only be consumed downstairs. Wine will be available by the glass or the bottle.

#### **PARKING**

All non-BYC members must park in the Johnson Street Parking Lot.

#### TRAILERS

All trailers must be removed from BYC and parked in the Johnson Street Parking Lot

#### **CAMPING**

Camping will be permitted on Friday and Saturday night.

#### ACCOMMODATION

A special Regatta rate is being negotiated with a local hotel.
